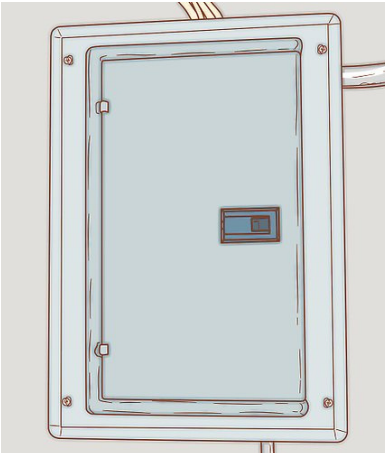


Flipping a Tripped Breaker

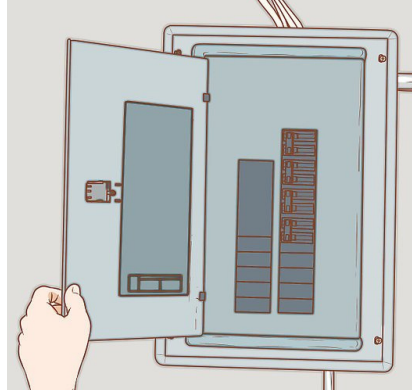
1

Locate the breaker panel in your home. Check your hands for moisture.



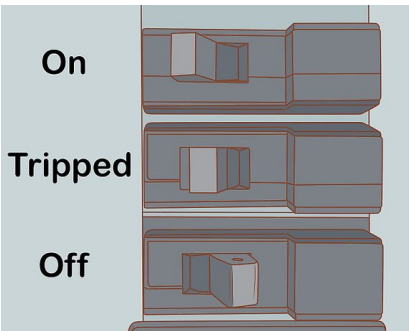
2

Open the breaker panel lid with one hand.



3

Look for any switch that is fully or partially tripped.



4

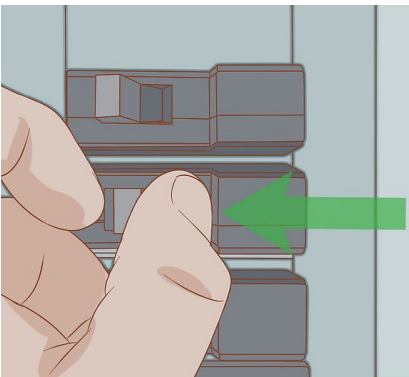
Refer to the breaker diagram if you need help finding the tripped switch.

Call an electrician immediately if the breaker panel feels hot.



5

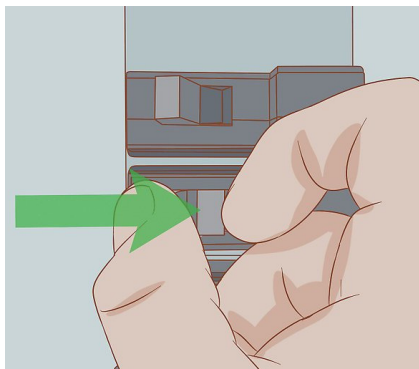
Flip the switch all the way to the OFF side.



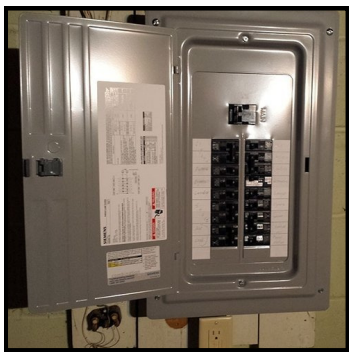

Turn the switch all the way back to the ON side.

Check to ensure the power is working.



Power Outage? Check Your Breakers First!

Check the main breaker panel inside your house.
(Refer to the other side of this brochure)

Locate your meter; it may be on a pole or pedestal outside at your main service.

Check your hands for moisture.
Open the breaker panel lid with one hand, underneath the main meter.



4

Check if the breaker underneath the meter is tripped. If your meter is BLANK, the power is OFF from your utility.



5

If tripped, flip the breaker to the OFF position and back to the ON position. You could experience resistance in resetting the breaker - this is normal.

Check to ensure the power is working.
